

English:

Throughout this term we will be improving our spelling, punctuation and grammar skills. We will practise these throughout the curriculum and feature them in our discussion text on the use of palm oil and our non-chronological report on plants in science. We will then be writing our own adventure story based in the Amazon rainforest using everything we have learned.

Maths:

This term we will be focusing on place value. We will be looking at the value of each digit in 3 and 4 digit numbers, comparing and ordering these numbers and looking at Roman numerals up to 1,000. We will then focus on counting in 25's, 50's, 100's and 1,000's and finding 1, 10,100 and 1,000 more or less than a given number. We will then move on to looking at negative numbers, rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000 and working on our reasoning and problem solving skills.

Science:

In science our main focus is plants, specifically ones found within the Amazon Rainforest. We will be looking at the main functions of the different parts of a plant, explore the requirements of a plant for life and growth and investigate the ways in which water is transported within plants.

Theme:

Our Theme for this term is Brazil: we will be looking at the Amazon Rainforest and the animals and plants that live there. We will be creating art work using a variety of materials to produce our own Brazilian plants and animals. We will then be looking at the features of villages, towns and cities within Brazil as well as improving our map skills.

PE & Games:

On Wednesdays we will have a tennis coach in school. He will be teaching us the basic rules and skills needed to play a game of tennis.

RE:

Our main question is – What do Christians learn from the Creation story?

We will be looking at the wonderful world around us and making clear links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation.
