<p>Open up the 2Do which has the tune for 'Twinkle, twinkle, little star'. Add your own instruments below to and experiment with your own sounds and tempos.</p> <p>It might look something like on the right.</p>	
<p>See if you can change the volume of the different rows. On the right of row will be a volume bar (shown in image on the right) . Experiment by making some louder and some quieter.</p>	
<p>Think about how different music makes you feel. Some music might make you feel happy whereas some might make you feel sad or scared.</p>	<p>See if you can make a tune that shows how you are feeling. Save it in your 'my work' folder so that I can listen to them!</p>
