<p><u>Activity 1</u> - Bug scavenger hunt. Have a search in your garden or on you daily walk for different bugs. Draw a small diagram of them and try to find out their names.</p> <p>Challenge: Create an information leaflet on all of the bugs you find.</p>	Paper
<p><u>Activity 2</u>- Create nature colour wheel/art with nature Collect some items from your garden or on your daily walk, find an item from each colour of the wheel. Can you create a piece of artwork including some of the things you find?</p> 	Paper Items collected from outside Glue/Sellotape Pens/pencils
<p><u>Activity 3</u> – Does it float or sink? Find a large bucket or bowl and fill it with water. Using items that you can find, predict if they will float or sink.</p> <p>Challenge: write a conclusion for your experiment. What did you find out?</p>	Bucket/bowl Items found around the garden
<p><u>Activity 4</u> -Sun Dial Become a human sun dial. Draw an 'x' on the floor in chalk to mark where you'll stand. Ask an adult or a sibling to draw around your shadow. Repeat this at different times of the day.</p> <p>Challenge: measure your shadow and different times of the day and record your results in a table.</p>	Chalk
