Work through the different sounds during the week. 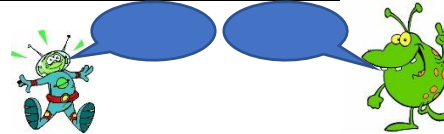
**Challenge:** Can you design your poster to show all 5 different emotions (anger/red, joy/yellow, sadness/blue, fear/purple, disgust/green).
