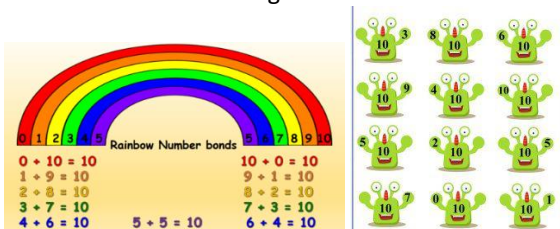
Use the link above to practice doubling together, discussing doubling with your child. Use lego or any small resources to all him to practice and show you his understanding of doubling.

Within this link, practice the following sounds – ee, igh, oa, or
 Watch through first, and then turn off the sound and ask your child to 'Fred-talk' (sound out) each word and then blend each one.
 Work through the different sounds during the week.
 If confident on these sounds, feel free to explore some of the other ones.

Children need to be really secure with tricky words, so use the tricky words ppt together to practice a bit more. If secure, ask your child to write the words (or sound out) as you say them.
