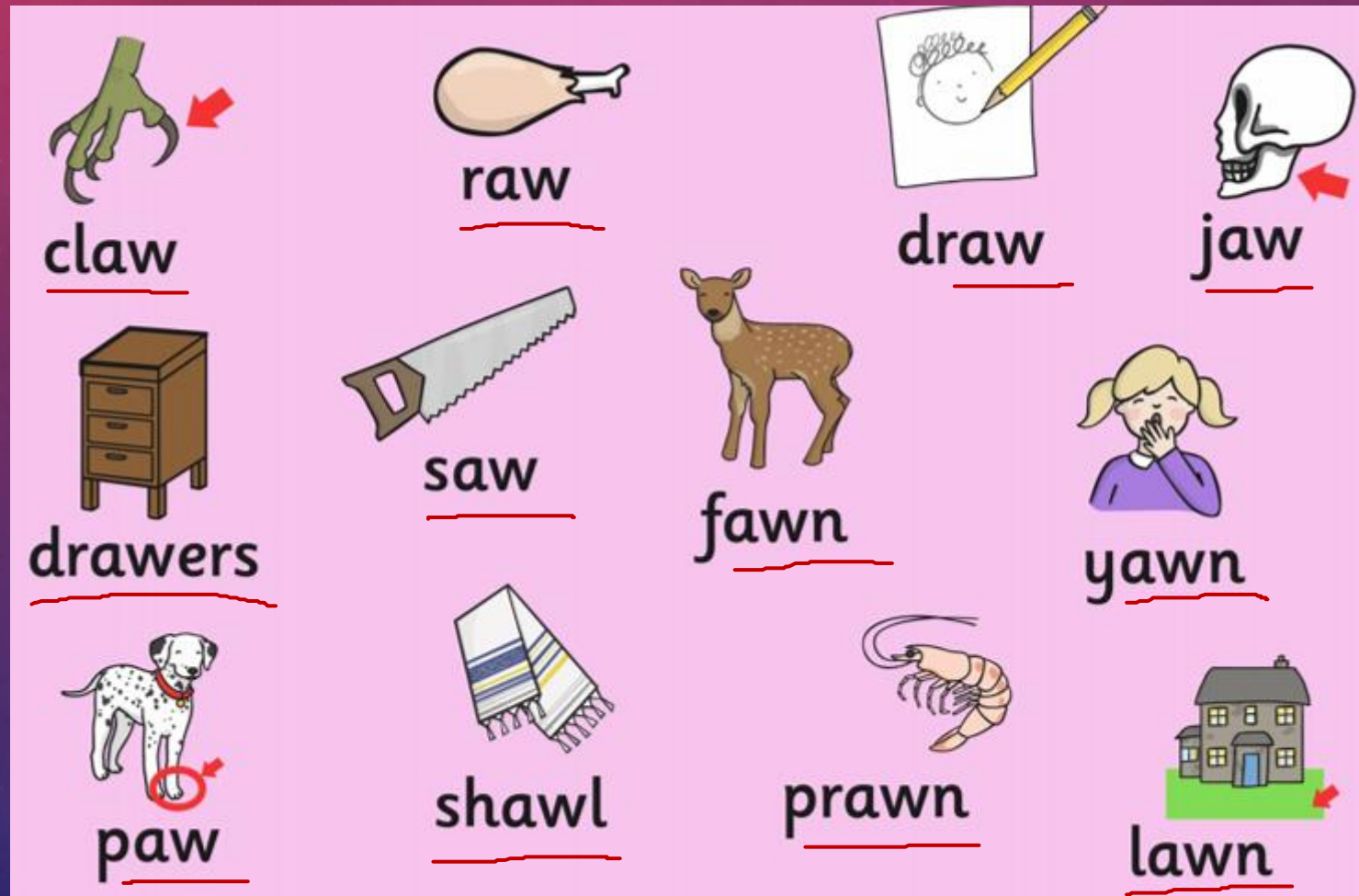


## New Sound: 'aw'

The 'aw' digraph makes the same sound as the 'or' digraph



Let's read some words with the 'aw' sound together.  
Notice the 'aw' sound can be at the end or in the middle of a word.

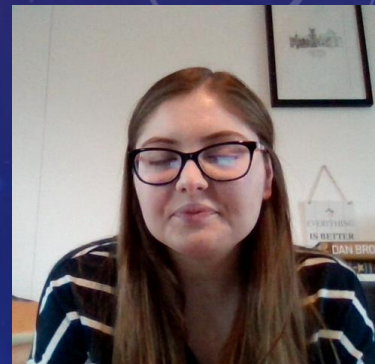
