






New Sound: 'aw'

The 'aw' digraph makes the same sound as the 'or' digraph








Let's read some words with the 'aw' sound together.

I think I will draw a picture of Storm to cheer her up.


How is your pet bird? I hope she doesn't get anything stuck in her claws!
