As you heard in our assembly, for book week we are celebrating the work of Julia Donaldson. Your first task will be to research facts about her to write in a fact file. Watch this interview with the lady herself to get started....she is being interviewed by a group of school children.

So what facts do we know so far about Julia Donaldson before you start researching her yourself or with your learning partner.

- \checkmark She is an author and a poet.
- ✓ She has written over 150 books for children.
- ✓ Many of her books are illustrated by Axel Scheffler.
- ✓ Her most famous book, The Gruffalo was published in 1999 and has sold more than 10 million copies.
- \checkmark She used to be a teacher.
- ✓ Most of her books rhyme or have rhyming elements.
- ✓ She has written reading books for children in school called Songbirds.
- ✓ Her first book was 'A Squash and a Squeeze' originally a song for a BBC children's programme.

One thing I hadn't particularly considered is the messages that her stories contain, for example Self-esteem- The Gruffalo; Deafness – Freddie and the Fairy; Sharing – Sharing a Shell; Counting – Spinderella Reading – The Detective Dog ...and there are probably many more messages.



Your task is to create a Julia Donaldson fact file.

If you are in KS2, perhaps you could imagine you are going to interview Julia Donaldson, and think of some questions you would like to ask her, then research the answers to these questions.

Your fact sheet should include:

Title, sub-headings, introductory sentence, final 'Did you know....?' sentence.

Some possible sub-headings might be....

- Before Becoming an Author
- Julia The Author
- First book/latest book
- Charity work
- Quotes
- Funny facts
- Awards

...depending on what you would like to know about her.

You should include a picture of her, and a bit about her family life.
