















## Jools and World Book Day!



On World Book Day, Jools went to school with his bookbag. He was dressed up as a cool pirate with a hook!





He sat in the book corner with his friend Brook and they looked at a book about animals in the zoo. The book was really good!





In the afternoon, it was Woodlands! Jools pulled his boots on each foot and put up his hood in case it rained.

Listen for the 'oo' sound as we read together and highlight the words with the 'oo' sound.












