



Tricky Words


Practice reading this weeks tricky words...

There are some trickier ones at the end.




Add the missing 'ie' sound to these words.

Real or Alien Words?





Dr. Suess was an American author. He was born on 2nd March 1904, 117 years ago! He wrote lots of books that rhymed!






Read this quote from Dr. Suess:
