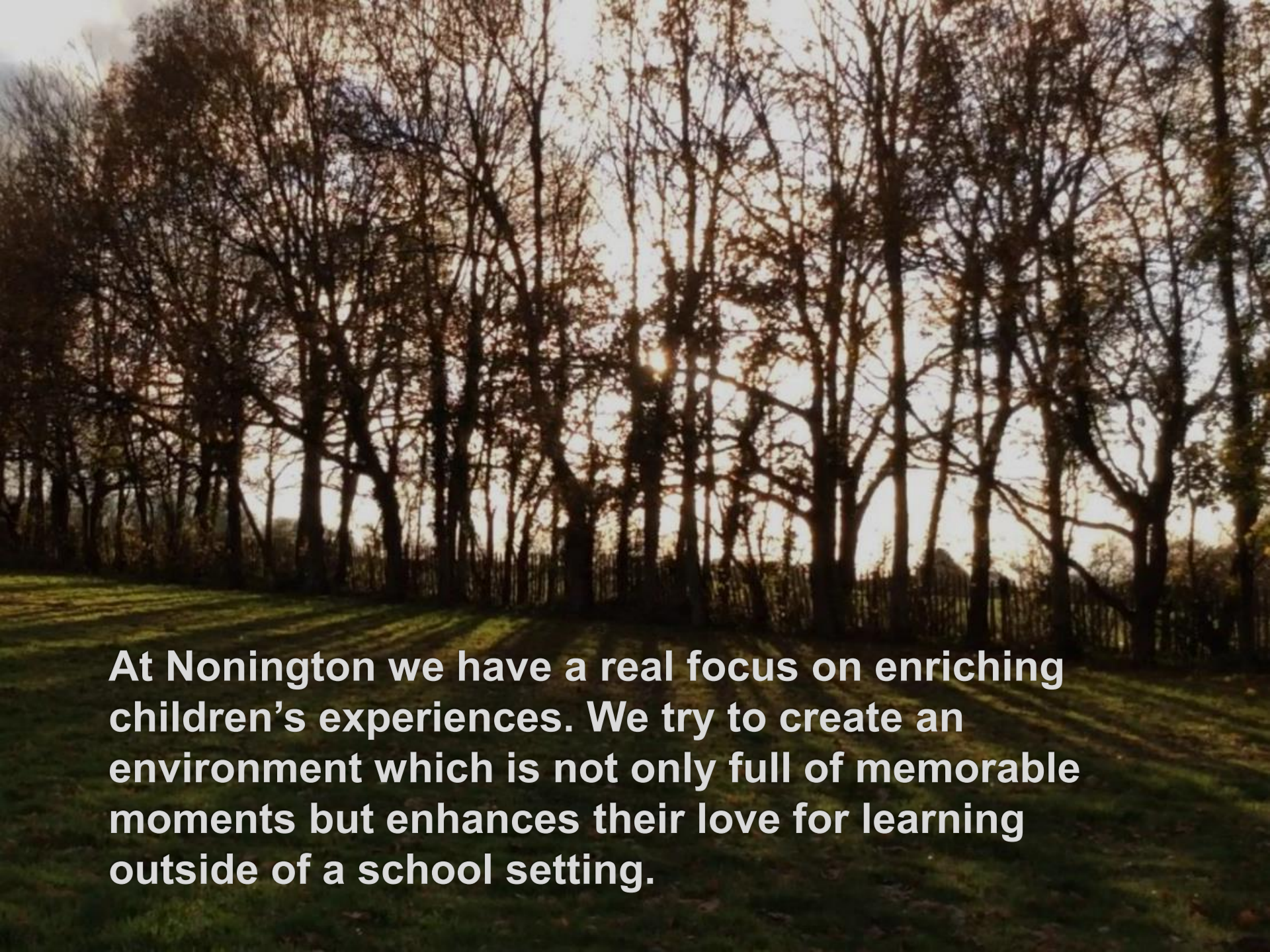


Sports is an integral part of life at Nonington. We offer a rich, well-structured PE curriculum which involves specialists to ensure that pupils build on and develop skills effectively.
