Maths:

All the children will be working hard on multiplication this term. Year 4 will concentrate on the 7's, Year 3 will be looking at their 4 times tables and year 2 will be exploring the 2's.

Science:

During our learning in science this term, the children will be learning about magnets and forces. How things attract and items react to the forces around them.

French:

During the term, the children will be learning about colours, shapes, animals and feelings.
